### **EDCS DRESS CODE FOR GIRLS, GRADES K-4**

ALL CLOTHING MUST RESEMBLE EDUCATIONAL APPAREL IN STYLE and COLOR.

Items may be purchased according to the following code, **as long as all items purchased resemble EDCS-selected styles from Educational Apparel:**

- 1 = Educational Apparel
- 2 = French Toast
- 3 = Stout Enterprises
- 4 = Purchase from any company

- Navy Jumper:** Solid navy with rounded neck or V-neck. Length should be no shorter than the top of the knee when standing and jumper must resemble E.A. in style. (4)
- Plaid Jumper:** Plaid jumper from E.A., French Toast, or Stout Enterprises (blue/red plaid only). Length should be no shorter than the top of the knee when standing and must resemble E.A. in style. (1,2)
- Slacks:** Solid navy or dark tan poly/cotton, ankle-length dress pants. No patch pockets or pockets on the legs. Style and color must resemble E.A. (4)
- Uniform (ONLY) Shorts:** Navy or dark tan knee-length shorts from E.A. or French Toast only. **NO CAPRI PANTS**. Please follow the school calendar for months that shorts may be worn. (1,2)
- Belts:** GRADES 2 AND UP. Solid colors with no ornamentation – Navy, blue, white, black, brown, or gray belt is required with all pants and shorts that have belt loops unless the banded polo is worn. Belts are optional for grades K and 1. (4)
- Blouses:** Cotton, button-up short- or long-sleeved with round collar – white or light blue. (4)
- White Polo Shirts:** Plain white polo; banded polo shirt may be worn with no belt. (4)
- Eagle Polo Shirts:** Navy, light blue, gold, or white with EDCS Eagle emblem; banded polo shirt may be worn with no belt. (1,3)
- Turtlenecks:** White, light blue, navy (4)
- Undershirts:** Solid white (only) undershirts may be worn under all uniform shirts. (4)
- Sweaters:** Solid navy crew-neck cardigan; solid navy pullover v-neck (4)
- Sweater vests:** Solid navy v-neck sweater vests or EDCS navy sweater vests (4)
- School sweatshirts:** School sweatshirts with EDCS Eagle emblem, with or without hood. (1,3)
- Sweatshirts:** Solid navy with no hood or pockets (4)
- P.E. Uniform:** Grades 3-12 – purchase through E.A. or Stout Enterprises only. (1,3)  
Solid navy sweatpants may be worn over P.E. shorts in cold weather.  
Sweatpants may have a solid stripe on the leg. (4)  
Socks and tennis shoes with a non-marking sole are required for P.E. (4)
- Socks:** Navy, white, light blue, dark tan (includes tights and cable tights); socks should be visible at all times. **In cold weather, solid navy, solid black, or solid white leggings may be worn under jumpers only.** (If the shoe obscures the sock, as with high-tops or boots, the student may be asked to show that she is wearing socks during dress code checks.) (4)
- Shoes:** For safety reasons, shoes must have a back on the heel and sandals must have a heel strap. (4)
- Earrings:** No more than two earrings per ear. **NO BODY PIERCING OR TATOOS.** (4)
- Bracelets:** A maximum of two bracelets per arm may be worn at one time. (4)
- Hair:** Well-groomed and natural coloring. No Mohawks, shaved designs, shaved heads (unless there is a medical reason), or distracting hairstyles. Shorter hair styles should be no more than 2-3 inches in thickness around the head. Hair may not be bleached or dyed
- Hair Accessories:** Barrettes, bows, headbands, and beads may be any reasonable color. No large or distracting hair accessories, and **NO BANDANAS.** (4)
- Make-up:** No makeup other than clear lip gloss may be worn by girls in grades K-6. Light-colored nail polish may be worn.

#### **Guidelines for Out-of-Dress-Code Days:**

- Ankle-length jeans – no skinny jeans, no sagging, no holes, no graffiti
- Ankle-length pants – no tight or sagging fit, no holes, no graffiti
- Jogging pants/sweat pants
- Uniform shorts ONLY
- Shirts with sleeves – must be waist-length or longer and meet EDCS philosophy
- Dress/Skirt – must be to the top of the knee or longer even if worn over leggings
- NO CAPRIS, NO SKORTS, NO BANDANAS

**Any violation of the above: Disciplinary action will occur as infractions are noted. The student may be kept out of class until correct clothing articles can be provided, they may receive a dress-code violation, or they may be sent home at the Administration's discretion.**

**Boys/Grades K-4: Dress code varies by grade level. Please consult the appropriate dress code for your student(s).**

### **EDCS DRESS CODE FOR BOYS, GRADES K-4**

ALL CLOTHING MUST RESEMBLE EDUCATIONAL APPAREL IN STYLE and COLOR.

Items may be purchased according to the following code, **as long as all items purchased resemble EDCS-selected styles from Educational Apparel:**

- 1 = Educational Apparel
- 2 = French Toast
- 3 = Stout Enterprises
- 4 = Purchase from any company

- Slacks:** Solid navy or dark tan poly/cotton, ankle-length dress pants. No patch pockets or pockets on the legs. Style and color must resemble E.A. (4)
- Uniform (ONLY) Shorts:** Navy or dark tan knee-length shorts from E.A. or French Toast only. Please follow the school calendar for months that shorts may be worn. (1,2) **NO CAPRI PANTS.**
- Belts:** GRADES 2 AND UP. Solid colors with no ornamentation – Navy, blue, white, black, brown, or gray belt is required with all pants and shorts that have belt loops unless the banded polo is worn. Belts are optional for grades K and 1. (4)
- Dress Shirts:** Cotton, button-up short- or long-sleeved with collar – white or light blue. (4)
- White Polo Shirts:** Plain white polo; banded polo shirt may be worn with no belt. (4)
- Eagle Polo Shirts:** Navy, light blue, gold, or white with Eagle emblem; banded polo shirt may be worn with no belt. (1,3)
- Turtlenecks:** White, light blue, navy (4)
- Undershirts:** Solid white (only) undershirts may be worn under all uniform shirts. (4)
- Sweaters:** Solid navy crew-neck cardigan; solid navy pullover v-neck (4)
- Sweater vests:** Solid navy v-neck sweater vests or EDCS navy sweater vests (4)
- School sweatshirts:** School sweatshirts with EDCS Eagle emblem, with or without hood. (1,3)
- Sweatshirts:** Solid navy with no hood or pockets (4)
- P.E. Uniform:** Grades 3-8, required – purchase through E.A. or Stout Enterprises only. (1,3)  
Solid navy sweatpants may be worn over P.E. shorts in cold weather.  
Sweatpants may have a solid stripe on the leg. (4)
- Socks:** Socks and tennis shoes with a non-marking sole are required for P.E. (4)  
Navy, white, light blue, dark tan; socks should be visible at all times. If the shoe obscures the sock, as with high-tops or boots, the student may be asked to show that he is wearing socks during dress code checks. (4)
- Shoes:** For safety reasons, shoes must have a back on the heel and sandals must have a heel strap. (4)
- Earrings:** Boys may not wear earrings or tattoos of any kind. No body piercings.
- Bracelets:** A maximum of two bracelets per arm may be worn at one time. (4)
- Hair:** Well-groomed and natural coloring. No Mohawks, shaved designs, shaved heads (unless there is a medical reason), or distracting hairstyles. Shorter hair styles should be no more than 2-3 inches in thickness around the head. Hair needs to be cut above the eyebrows, ears, and collar. Hair should not be bleached or dyed.
- Hair Accessories:** Caps or hats may not be worn during the school day except at recess. Please no inappropriate pictures or words.
- Make-up:** Boys are not allowed to wear makeup. Clear lip balm is not considered to be makeup.

#### **Guidelines for Out-of-Dress-Code Days:**

- Ankle-length jeans – no skinny jeans, no sagging, no holes, no graffiti
- Ankle-length pants – no tight or sagging fit, no holes, no graffiti
- Jogging pants/sweat pants

ALL CLOTHING MUST RESEMBLE EDUCATIONAL APPAREL IN STYLE and COLOR.

Items may be purchased according to the following code, **as long as all items purchased resemble EDCS-selected styles from Educational Apparel:**

- 1 = Educational Apparel
- 2 = French Toast
- 3 = Stout Enterprises
- 4 = Purchase from any company

- Navy Skirt:** Solid navy pleated skirts must resemble E.A. in style. **NO SKORTS.** Length should be no shorter than the top of the knee when standing. (1,2)
- Plaid Skirt:** Plaid skirt (blue/red plaid) from E.A., French Toast, or Stout Enterprises only. **NO SKORTS.** Length should be no shorter than the top of the knee when standing. (1,2)
- Slacks:** Solid navy or dark tan poly/cotton, ankle-length dress pants. No patch pockets or pockets on the legs. Style and color must resemble E.A. (4)
- Uniform (ONLY) Shorts:** Navy or dark tan knee-length shorts from E.A. or French Toast only. Please follow the school calendar for months that shorts may be worn. (1,2)
- Belts:** GRADES 2 AND UP. Solid colors with no ornamentation – Navy, blue, white, black, brown, or gray belt is required with all pants and shorts that have belt loops unless the banded polo is worn. (4)
- Blouses:** Short- or long-sleeved oxford-cloth blouse with button-down collar in white or light blue(4)
- White Polo Shirts:** Plain white polo; banded polo shirt may be worn with no belt. (4)
- Eagle Polo Shirts:** Navy, light blue, gold, or white with Eagle emblem; banded polo shirt may be worn with no belt. (1,3)
- Turtlenecks:** White, light blue, navy (4)
- Undershirts:** Solid white (only) undershirts may be worn under all uniform shirts. (4)
- Sweaters:** Solid navy crew-neck cardigan; solid navy pullover v-neck (4)
- Sweater vests:** Solid navy v-neck sweater vests or EDCS navy sweater vests (4)
- School sweatshirts:** School sweatshirts with EDCS Eagle emblem, with or without hood. (1,3)

Solid navy sweatpants may be worn over P.E. shorts in cold weather.

Socks and tennis shoes with a non-marking sole are required for P.E. (4)
- Socks:** Navy, white, light blue, dark tan (includes tights and cable tights); socks should be visible at all times. **In cold weather, solid navy, solid black, or solid white leggings may be worn under skirts only.** (If the shoe obscures the sock, as with high-tops or boots, the student may be asked to show that she is wearing socks during dress code checks.) (4)
- Shoes:** For safety reasons shoes must be worn at all times. Shoes must have a back on the heel and sandals must have a heel strap. Heel height should not exceed 2". (4)
- Earrings:** No more than two earrings per ear. NO BODY PIERCING OR TATOOS. (4)
- Bracelets:** A maximum of two bracelets per arm may be worn at one time. (4)
- Hair:** Well-groomed and natural coloring. No Mohawks, shaved designs, shaved heads (unless there is a medical reason), or distracting hairstyles. Shorter hair styles should be no more than 2-3 inches in thickness around the head. Hair may not be bleached or dyed.
- Hair Accessories:** Barrettes, bows, headbands, and beads may be any reasonable color. No large or distracting hair accessories, and NO BANDANAS. (4)
- Make-up:** No makeup other than clear lip gloss may be worn by girls in grades K-6. Nail polish may be worn.
- Chapel Dress:** Navy skirt, white oxford shirt, button down collar (optional), (resembles EA), socks or hose, navy sweater (if needed)

- Navy Skirt:** Solid navy pleated skirts must resemble E.A. in style. **NO SKORTS.** Length should be no shorter than the top of the knee when standing. (4)
- Plaid Skirt:** Blue/red plaid from E.A., French Toast, or Stout Enterprises only. **NO SKORTS.** Length should be no shorter than the top of the knee when standing. (1,2)
- Slacks:** Solid navy or dark tan poly/cotton, ankle-length dress pants. No patch pockets or pockets on the legs. Style and color must resemble E.A. (4)
- Uniform (ONLY) Shorts:** Navy or dark tan knee-length shorts from E.A. or French Toast only. Please follow the school calendar for months that shorts may be worn. **NO CAPRI PANTS** (1,2)
- Belts:** GRADES 2 AND UP. Solid colors with no ornamentation – Navy, blue, white, black, brown, or gray belt is required with all pants and shorts that have belt loops unless the banded polo is worn. (4)
- Blouses:** Short- or long-sleeved oxford-cloth blouse with button-down collar in white or light blue (4)

- Socks:** Navy, white, light blue, dark tan (includes tights and cable tights.) In cold weather, solid navy, solid black, or solid white leggings may be worn under skirts only. (4) No socks are required except with P.E. uniform.
- Shoes:** For safety reasons, shoes must be worn at all times. Heel height should not exceed 2". (4)
- Earrings:** No more than two earrings per ear. **NO BODY PIERCING OR TATOOS.** (4)
- Bracelets:** A maximum of two bracelets per arm may be worn at one time. (4)
- Hair:** Well-groomed and natural coloring. If a student colors her hair, the color must be a natural color with subtle style; highlights should be blended through the hair rather than in obvious “chunks.” No Mohawks, shaved designs, shaved heads (unless there is a medical reason), or distracting hairstyles. Shorter hair styles should be no more than 2-3 inches in thickness around the head.
- Hair Accessories:** Barrettes, bows, headbands, and beads may be any reasonable color. No large or distracting hair accessories. **NO BANDANAS.** (4)
- Make-up:** Junior high and high school girls may wear light make-up and nail polish. Determination of appropriateness is at the discretion of administration.
- Chapel Dress:** Navy skirt, white oxford shirt, button down collar (optional), (resembles EA), socks or hose (optional), navy sweater (if needed)

<b>Slacks:</b>	Solid navy or dark tan poly/cotton, ankle-length dress pants. No patch pockets or pockets on the legs. Style and color must resemble E.A. (4)
<b>Uniform (ONLY) Shorts:</b>	Navy or dark tan knee-length shorts from <u>E.A. or French Toast only</u> . Please follow the school calendar for months that shorts may be worn. <u>NO CAPRI PANTS</u> . (1,2)
<b>Belts:</b>	GRADES 2 AND UP. Solid colors with no ornamentation – Navy, blue, white, black, brown, or gray belt is required with all pants and shorts that have belt loops unless the banded polo is worn. (4)
<b>Dress Shirts:</b>	Short- or long-sleeved <u>oxford-cloth with button-down collar</u> in white or light blue(4)
<b>Plain Polo Shirts:</b>	<u>Plain</u> white, light blue, navy, or gold polo; banded polo shirt may be worn with no belt. (4)
<b>Eagle Polo Shirts:</b>	Navy, light blue, gold, or white <u>with Eagle emblem</u> ; banded polo shirt may be worn with no belt. (1,3)
<b>Turtlenecks:</b>	White, light blue, navy (4)
<b>Undershirts:</b>	Solid white (only) undershirts may be worn under all uniform shirts. (4)
<b>Sweaters:</b>	Solid navy crew-neck cardigan; solid navy pullover v-neck (4)
<b>Sweater vests:</b>	Solid navy v-neck sweater vests or EDCS navy sweater vests (4)
<b>School sweatshirts:</b>	School sweatshirts <u>with EDCS Eagle emblem</u> , with or without hood. (1,3)
<b>Sweatshirts:</b>	Solid navy with no hood or pockets (4)
<b>P.E. Uniform:</b>	Grades 3-12 – purchase through E.A. or Stout Enterprises only. (1,3) Solid navy sweatpants may be worn over P.E. shorts in cold weather. Sweatpants may have a solid stripe on the leg. (4) Socks and tennis shoes with a non-marking sole are required for P.E. (4)

Hair needs to be cut above the eyebrows, ears, and collar. <b>No facial hair, sideburns, mustaches or beards are allowed.</b> If a student colors his hair, the color must be a natural color with subtle style; highlights should be blended through the hair rather than in obvious “chunks.”
<b>Hair Accessories:</b>	Caps or hats may not be worn during the school day. Please, no inappropriate pictures or words.
<b>Make-up:</b>	Boys are not allowed to wear makeup. Clear lip balm is not considered to be makeup.
<b>Chapel Dress:</b>	Navy dress pants, white oxford shirt, button down collar (optional), (resembles EA), belt, socks (optional), navy striped tie <u>from E.A. only</u> , navy sweater (if needed)

#### **Guidelines for Out-of-Dress-Code Days:**

- Ankle-length jeans – no skinny jeans, no sagging, no holes, no graffiti
- Ankle-length pants – no tight or sagging fit, no holes, no graffiti
- Jogging pants/sweat pants
- Uniform shorts ONLY
- Shirts with sleeves – must be waist-length or longer and meet EDCS philosophy
- NO CAPRIS, NO BANDANAS
- No attire that advertises or promotes area high schools other than EDCS is allowed.

**Any violation of the above: Disciplinary action will occur as infractions are noted. The student may be kept out of class until correct clothing articles can be provided, they may receive a dress-code violation, or they may be sent home at the Administration’s discretion.**

**Young Ladies/HighSchool: Dress code varies by grade level. Please consult the appropriate dress code for your student(s).**

### **EDCS DRESS CODE FOR YOUNG LADIES, GRADES 9-12**

<b>Skirts:</b>	Any knee-length or longer skirt(except white); <u>length should be to the top of the knee when standing, even if worn over leggings. NO SKORTS.</u>
<b>Slacks:</b>	Full-length, solid color (except white), cotton, corduroy, or dress pants. <u>NO JEANS, NO CAPRI PANTS, NO SAGGING, and NO SKINNY-FIT pants.</u>
<b>Shorts:</b>	Educational Apparel or French Toast knee-length short (EDCS selected items only.)
<b>Belts:</b>	To match clothing – required with pants or shorts when waistband (with belt loops) shows.
<b>Shirts:</b>	Collared shirts with sleeves (either button-down or polo style), dress knit shirt of any color (no thin or sheer fabrics, please); must be at waist or longer so that skin is not visible at the waistline; <u>NO LOW OR REVEALING NECKLINES.</u>
<b>Turtlenecks:</b>	Any color.
<b>Sweaters:</b>	Appropriate styles of any color may be worn (No hood, no words, no pictures)
<b>School sweatshirts:</b>	School sweatshirts <u>with EDCS Eagle emblem</u> , with or without hood.
<b>Sweatshirts:</b>	Any plain solid-colored sweatshirt (No hood, no words, no pictures)
<b>P.E. Uniform:</b>	Grades 3-12 – purchase through E.A. or Stout Enterprises only. Solid navy sweatpants may be worn over P.E. shorts in cold weather. Sweatpants may have a solid stripe on the leg. Socks and tennis shoes with a non-marking sole are required for P.E.
<b>Socks:</b>	Any reasonable style socks or hose are allowed, but they are not required.
<b>Shoes:</b>	For safety reasons, shoes must be worn at all times. Heel height should not exceed 2 ½ ”.
<b>Earrings:</b>	No more than two earrings per ear. NO BODY PIERCING OR TATOOS.
<b>Bracelets:</b>	A maximum of two bracelets per arm may be worn at one time.
<b>Hair:</b>	Well-groomed and natural coloring. If a student colors her hair, the color must be a natural color with subtle style; highlights should be blended through the hair rather than in obvious “chunks.” No Mohawks, shaved designs, shaved heads (unless there is a medical reason), or distracting hairstyles. Shorter hair styles should be no more than 2-3 inches in thickness around the head.
<b>Hair Accessories:</b>	Barrettes, bows, headbands, and beads may be any reasonable color. No large or distracting hair accessories, and NO BANDANAS.
<b>Make-up:</b>	Junior high and high school girls may wear light make-up and nail polish. Determination of appropriateness is at the discretion of administration.
<b>Chapel Dress:</b>	Navy or black skirt, dress shirt/blouse, socks or hose (optional), navy or black sweater (if needed)

### **Guidelines for Out-of-Dress-Code Days:**

- Ankle-length jeans – no skinny jeans, no sagging, no holes, no graffiti
- Ankle-length pants – no tight or sagging fit, no holes, no graffiti
- Jogging pants/sweat pants
- Uniform shorts ONLY
- Shirts with sleeves – must be waist-length or longer and meet EDCS philosophy
- Dress/Skirt – must be to the top of the knee or longer even if worn over leggings
- NO CAPRIS, NO SKORTS, NO BANDANAS
- No attire that advertises or promotes area high schools other than EDCS is allowed.

**Any violation of the above: Disciplinary action will occur as infractions are noted. The student may be kept out of class until correct clothing articles can be provided, they may receive a dress-code violation, or they may be sent home at the Administration’s discretion.**

**Young Men/High School: Dress code varies by grade level. Please consult the appropriate dress code for your student(s).**

### **EDCS DRESS CODE FOR YOUNG MEN, GRADES 9-12**

<b>Slacks:</b>	Full-length, solid color (except white), cotton, corduroy, or dress pants. <u>NO JEANS, NO CAPRI PANTS, NO SAGGING, and NO SKINNY-FIT</u> pants.
<b>Shorts:</b>	Educational Apparel or French Toast knee-length short (EDCS selected items only.)
<b>Belts:</b>	To match clothing – required with pants or shorts when waistband (with belt loops) shows.
<b>Shirts:</b>	Collared shirts with sleeves, either button-down or polo style, any color (no thin or sheer fabrics.)
<b>Turtlenecks:</b>	Any color.
<b>Sweaters:</b>	Appropriate styles of any color may be worn. (No hood, no words, no pictures)
<b>School sweatshirts:</b>	School sweatshirts <u>with EDCS Eagle emblem</u> , with or without hood.
<b>Sweatshirts:</b>	Any plain solid-colored sweatshirt (No hood, no words, no pictures)
<b>P.E. Uniform:</b>	Grades 3-12 – purchase through E.A. or Stout Enterprises only. Solid navy sweatpants may be worn over P.E. shorts in cold weather. Sweatpants may have a solid stripe on the leg. Socks and tennis shoes with a non-marking sole are required for P.E.
<b>Socks:</b>	Any reasonable style socks are allowed, but they are not required.
<b>Shoes:</b>	For safety reasons, shoes are required at all times.
<b>Earrings:</b>	Young men may <u>not</u> wear earrings or tattoos of any kind. <b>NO</b> body piercings.
<b>Bracelets:</b>	A maximum of two bracelets per arm may be worn at one time.
<b>Hair:</b>	Well-groomed and natural coloring. The appearance of hair should be neat: no hair in the eyes, neatly trimmed on the sides, and not below the collar in the back. If a student colors his hair, the color must be a natural color with subtle style; highlights should be blended through the hair rather than in obvious “chunks.” No Mohawks, shaved designs, shaved heads (unless there is a medical reason), or distracting hairstyles. Shorter hair styles should be no more than 2-3 inches in thickness around the head.
<b>Facial Hair</b>	No mustaches or beards. Sideburns should be well-trimmed and may not extend below the ear.
<b>Accessories:</b>	No caps or hats may be worn during the school day, and <u>NO bandanas</u> may be worn.
<b>Make-up:</b>	Boys are not allowed to wear makeup. Clear lip balm is not considered makeup.
<b>Chapel Dress:</b>	Navy or black pants, dress shirt (tucked in at all times), socks (optional), belt, appropriate tie, navy or black sweater (if needed)

### **Guidelines for Out-of-Dress-Code Days:**

- Ankle-length jeans – no skinny jeans, no sagging, no holes, no graffiti
- Ankle-length pants – no tight or sagging fit, no holes, no graffiti
- Jogging pants/sweat pants
- Uniform shorts **ONLY**
- Shirts with sleeves – must be waist-length or longer and meet EDCS philosophy
- **NO CAPRIS, NO BANDANAS**
- No attire that advertises or promotes area high schools other than EDCS is allowed.
