EDCS DRESS CODE FOR GIRLS, GRADES K-4

Dress code varies by grade level. Please consult the appropriate dress code for your student(s).

Polos must be worn at all times, even underneath outerwear.

Please note that skirts are not part of the approved school uniform.

Items may be purchased according to the following code, <u>as long as all items purchased resemble EDCS-selected styles from Educational Apparel:</u>

- 1 = Educational Apparel
- 2 = French Toast
- 3 = Purchase from any company

Navy Jumper:

• Solid navy with rounded neck or V-neck. Length should be no shorter than the top of the knee when standing and jumper must resemble E.A. in style. (3)

Plaid Jumper:

• Plaid jumper from E.A. or French Toast (blue/red plaid only). Length should be no shorter than the top of the knee when standing and must resemble E.A. in style. (1,2)

Slacks:

• Solid navy or dark tan poly/cotton, ankle-length dress pants. No pockets on the legs. <u>Style and color must resemble E.A. (3)</u>

Uniform (ONLY) Shorts:

• Navy or dark tan knee-length shorts from <u>E.A.</u>, <u>French Toast or uniform company</u>. <u>NO CAPRI PANTS</u>. Please follow the school calendar for months that shorts may be worn. (1,2,3)

Belts:

• GRADES 2 AND UP. Must be worn if belt loops are showing.

Blouses:

• Cotton, button-up short or long-sleeved with rounded or pointed collar—white or light blue. (3)

Plain Polo Shirts:

• Light blue & white polo; banded polo shirt may be worn with no belt. (3)

Eagle Polo Shirts:

• Navy & gold polo MUST have the <u>EDCS emblem</u>; banded polo shirt may be worn with no belt.(1)

Undershirts:

• Solid white (only) undershirts may be worn under all uniform shirts. (3)

Sweaters/sweater vests: Solid navy (3)

Sweatshirts: School sweatshirts (1) or solid navy with no hood (3)

P.E. Uniform: Grades 3-8

- Shirt purchase through E.A. only. (1)
- Shorts solid navy blue mesh gym shorts must resemble E.A. in style. (1,3)
- Solid navy sweatpants or gym pants are required to be worn over P.E. shorts in cold weather. Pants may have solid stripes on the leg. (3)

- Socks and tennis shoes with a non-marking sole are required for P.E. (3)
- Tennis shoes must be worn on gym floor.

Socks:

• Socks, tights, leggings of any color. Socks or tights must be worn at all times. (3)

Shoes:

 Athletic shoes are preferred due to safety reasons. Any gym shoes or other shoes worn with black soles must be non-marking (those are identified as such when purchased). Some footwear can be very hazardous, especially on the playground. For this reason, flip-flops, clogs, thongs, sandals, heelys (skate shoes), crocs, house slippers, booties, as well as shoes or boots with higher than normal heels, are not permitted. Boots may be worn to school but students must change into gym shoes upon arrival.

Piercings/Tattoos:

• No more than two earrings per ear. Gauges are not permitted. No visible Tattoos and/or body piercings on campus or school related events.

Hair:

• Well-groomed and natural coloring. No Mohawks or shaved designs. Shorter hair styles should be no more than 2-3 inches in thickness around the head. Hair may not be bleached or dyed.

Hair Accessories:

• Barrettes, bows, headbands, and beads may be any color. Caps or hats may not be worn during the school day except at recess. Please no inappropriate pictures or words.

Make-up:

• No makeup other than clear lip gloss may be worn by girls in grades K-4.

*All shirts, except for banded polo's, must be tucked in at all times.

Guidelines for Out-of-Dress-Code Days:

- Ankle-length jeans loose fitting, no sagging, no holes or frays, no graffiti
- Ankle –length pants no tight or sagging fit, no holes, no graffiti
- Leggings are not allowed unless worn under skirt/dress that is knee length.
- Jogging pants/sweatpants
- Uniform shorts ONLY
- Shirts with sleeves must be waist-length or longer and meet EDCS philosophy
- Skirt must be to the top of the knee or longer even if worn over leggings
- Dresses with sleeves, must be to the top of the knee or longer even if worn over leggings,
- NO CAPRIS, NO SKORTS
- No attire that advertises or promotes area high schools other than EDCS is allowed.

Any violation of the above: Disciplinary action will occur as infractions are noted. The student may be kept out of class until correct clothing articles can be provided, they may receive a dress-code violation, or they may be sent home at the Administration's discretion.

Items may be purchased according to the following code, <u>as long as all items purchased resemble EDCS-selected styles from Educational Apparel:</u>

- 1 = Educational Apparel
- 2 = French Toast
- 3 = Purchase from any company

Slacks:

• Solid navy or dark tan poly/cotton, ankle-length dress pants. No pockets on the legs. <u>Style and color must resemble E.A. (3)</u>

Uniform (ONLY) Shorts:

• Navy or dark tan knee-length shorts from <u>E.A.</u>, <u>French Toast or uniform company</u>. <u>NO CAPRI PANTS</u>. Please follow the school calendar for months that shorts may be worn. (1,2,3)

Belts:

• GRADES 2 AND UP. Must be worn if belt loops are showing.

Dress Shirts:

• Cotton, button-up short- or long-sleeved with rounded or pointed collar—white or light blue. (3)

Plain Polo Shirts:

• Light blue & white polo; banded polo shirt may be worn with no belt. (3)

Eagle Polo Shirts:

• Navy & gold polo MUST have the <u>EDCS emblem</u>; banded polo shirt may be worn with no belt.(1)

Undershirts:

• Solid white (only) undershirts may be worn under all uniform shirts. (3)

Sweaters/sweater vests: Solid navy (3)

Sweatshirts: School sweatshirts (1) or solid navy with no hood (3)

P.E. Uniform: Grades 3-8

- Shirt purchase through E.A. only. (1)
- Shorts solid navy blue mesh gym shorts must resemble E.A. in style. (1,3)
- Solid navy sweatpants or gym pants are required to be worn over P.E. shorts in cold weather. Pants may have solid stripes on the leg. (3)
- Socks and tennis shoes with a non-marking sole are required for P.E. (3)
- Tennis shoes must be worn on gym floor.

Socks:

• Any color. Must be worn at all times. (3)

Shoes:

• Athletic shoes are preferred due to safety reasons. Any gym shoes or other shoes worn with black soles must be non-marking (those are identified as such when purchased). Some footwear can be very hazardous, especially on the playground. For this reason, flip-flops, clogs, thongs, sandals, heelys (skate shoes), crocs, house slippers, booties, as well as shoes or boots with higher than normal heels, are not permitted. Boots may be worn to school but students must change into gym shoes upon arrival.

Piercings/Tattoos:

 Boys may not wear earrings. No visible Tattoos and/or body piercings on campus or school related events.

Hair:

• Well-groomed and natural coloring. No Mohawks or shaved designs. Shorter hair styles should be no more than 2-3 inches in thickness around the head. Hair needs to be off the collar, above the eyebrow and at least part of the ear showing. Hair may not be bleached or dyed.

Hair Accessories:

• Caps, hats, or bandanas may not be worn during the school day. Please no inappropriate pictures or words. Headbands are allowed only for purposes of keeping longer hair out of the face.

Make-up:

• Boys are not allowed to wear makeup.

*All shirts, except for banded polo's, must be tucked in at all times.

Guidelines for Out-of-Dress-Code Days:

- Ankle-length jeans loose fitting, no sagging, no holes or frays, no graffiti
- Ankle-length pants no tight or sagging fit including joggers, no holes, no graffiti
- Jogging pants/sweatpants
- Uniform shorts ONLY
- Shirts with sleeves must be waist-length or longer and meet EDCS philosophy
- NO CAPRIS
- No attire that advertises or promotes area high schools other than EDCS is allowed

Any violation of the above: Disciplinary action will occur as infractions are noted. The student may be kept out of class until correct clothing articles can be provided, they may receive a dress-code violation, or they may be sent home at the Administration's discretion
