UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS:

Purchase these items from EA ONLY:

P.E. uniform: Gold P.E. shirt and knee-length navy blue mesh/athletic shorts (4th/5th, only) Gold or navy polo shirt with logo All other embroidered items

Purchase these items from EA or French Toast (available at J.C. Penney & Amazon):

To ensure you are purchasing the correct style of pants/shorts, please use the following item numbers when shopping French Toast. If you are not shopping on campus, EA merchandise has been preselected on the website, so you do not need an item number. Just search "East Dayton Christian."

Navy or khaki straight leg or relaxed fit pants (not leggings, stretch, boot cut, slim fit, joggers, or cargos):

• Boys: 1519, 1694, 1695, or 1348

Navy or khaki knee-length shorts (same as above):

• Boys: 1699 or 1656

Purchase these items from any retailer:

<u>Solid</u> Navy, white, or light blue polo shirt **or** <u>solid</u> white button down/oxford (long or short sleeves)

<u>Solid</u> navy sweater, sweater vest, or sweatshirt (no hood/no emblems or logos unless purchased through EA)

Solid navy sweatpants/jogging pants (may have white stripes) for P.E.

ADDITIONAL DRESS CODE EXPECTATIONS:

Undershirts:

Solid white (only) undershirts may be worn under all uniform shirts.

Socks:

Any color. Must be worn at all times.

Shoes

 Closed toe and heel with non-marking soles must be worn. Snow boots may be worn to school but students must change into the appropriate shoes upon arrival. Neither Crocs nor sandals/slides may not be worn in grades K-5 due to recess activities.

Piercings/Tattoos:

 Boys may not wear earrings. No visible tattoos and/or body piercings on campus or school related events.

Hair:

- Well-groomed and natural coloring. If a student colors their hair, the color must be a natural color. No Mohawks.
- Shaved designs must meet EDCS philosophy. Hats are not to be worn during the school day, except for outdoor recess.

Hair Accessories:

 Caps, hats, or bandanas may not be worn during the school day except for outdoor recess. Please no inappropriate pictures or words.

Make-up:

• Boys are not allowed to wear makeup or nail polish.

Guidelines for Out-of-Dress-Code Days:

- Loose fitting, ankle-length pants or jeans. No holes that show skin.
- Appropriate fitting jogging pants/sweatpants
- Only knee-length uniform shorts may be worn.
- Shirts with sleeves must be waist-length or longer
- No attire that advertises or promotes area schools other than EDCS is allowed.
- All attire must meet EDCS philosophy.

Note:

• A uniform shirt must be worn at all times, even under outerwear (i.e., hoodies, sweatshirts, etc.)

Any violation of the above:

Depending on the severity of the infraction, students may be kept out of class until correct clothing articles can be provided, receive a dress-code violation, or be sent home at their administrator's discretion.

Four dress code violations will result in a detention.

UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS:

Purchase these items from EA ONLY:

Navy and plaid jumper (EA pattern #41/red-blue plaid)

P.E. uniform: Gold P.E. shirt and knee-length navy blue mesh/athletic shorts (4th/5th, only) Gold or navy polo shirt with logo

All other embroidered items

Purchase these items from EA or French Toast (available at J.C. Penney & Amazon):

Navy or khaki knee-length shorts (same as above):

• Girls: 1692 or 1396

Purchase these items from any retailer:

<u>Solid</u> navy sweater, sweater vest, or sweatshirt (no hood/no emblems or logos unless purchased through EA)

Solid navy sweatpants/jogging pants (may have white stripes) for P.E.

ADDITIONAL DRESS CODE EXPECTATIONS:

Undershirts:

• Solid white (only) undershirts may be worn under all uniform shirts.

Socks:

Socks, tights, leggings of any color. Socks or tights must be worn at all times.

Shoes

 Closed toe and heel with non-marking soles must be worn. Snow boots may be worn to school but students must change into the appropriate shoes upon arrival. Neither Crocs nor sandals/slides may not be worn in grades K-5 due to recess activities.

Piercings/Tattoos:

• No more than two earrings per ear. Gauges are not permitted. No visible tattoos and/or body piercings on campus or at school related events.

Hair:

- Well-groomed and natural coloring. If a student colors their hair, the color must be a natural color. No Mohawks.
- Shaved designs must meet EDCS philosophy. Hats are not to be worn during the school day, except for outdoor recess.

Hair Accessories:

 Barrettes, bows, headbands, and beads may be any color. Caps or hats may not be worn during the school day except for outdoor recess. Please no inappropriate pictures or words.

Make-up:

• No makeup other than clear lip gloss may be worn by girls in grades K-5.

Guidelines for Out-of-Dress-Code Days:

- Loose fitting, ankle-length pants or jeans. No holes that show skin.
- No leggings or jeggings are to be worn on their own (may be worn under dresses, skirts and uniform shorts).
- Only knee-length uniform shorts may be worn.
- Shirts with sleeves, waist length or longer.
- Skirt must be to the top of the knee or longer even if worn over leggings.
- Dresses with sleeves, must be to the top of the knee or longer even if worn over leggings.
- No attire that advertises or promotes area schools other than EDCS is allowed.
- All attire must meet EDCS philosophy.

Note:

- A uniform shirt must be worn at all times, even under outerwear (i.e., hoodies, sweatshirts, etc.)
- Neither skirts nor skorts are a part of the approved school uniform for elementary girls.

Any violation of the above:

Depending on the severity of the infraction, students may be kept out of class until correct clothing articles can be provided, receive a dress-code violation, or be sent home at their administrator's discretion.

Four dress code violations will result in a detention.
